# Division Play Off Formats

## Three (3) Teams

Teams will play a single round robin tournament format – this will require 3 round robin games.

Schedule:

1 vs 3 1 vs 2 2 vs 3

If Division Championship – The top two teams will play a divisional final game, for Gold and Silver. The winning team will advance to Super Sunday Weekend.

If League Championship – The second and third place teams will play a Semi-Final game, the Losing team will be awarded Bronze. The winner will advance and play the first place team for Gold and Silver on Super Sunday Weekend.

## Four (4) Teams

Teams will play a single round robin tournament format – this will require 6 round robin games.

## Six (6) Teams

Teams will be divided into two groups – this will require 9 round robin games.

The first group will consist of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> place teams.

The second group will consist of the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> place teams.

The teams in the first group will play each team in the second group.

If Division Championship – At the conclusion of round robin play, the top four teams, out of six, will advance to the semi-finals:

Semi Final 1: 1 vs 4

Semi Final 2: 2 vs 3

The winner of Semi Final #1 will play the winner of Semi-Final #2 for the divisional Gold and Silver. The winning team will advance to Super Sunday Weekend.

If League Championship – The top two teams will play for Gold and Silver. The third and fourth place teams will play for the Bronze, on Super Sunday Weekend.

## Seven (7) Teams

Teams will be divided into two groups – this will require 12 round robin games.

The first group (“A”) will consist of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> place teams.

The teams in the “A” group will play a double round robin.

Schedule:

## Eight (8) Teams

Teams will be divided into two groups – this will require 12 round robin games.

The first group (“A”) will consist of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> place teams.

The teams in the “A” group will play a single round robin.

The teams in “A” group will play a single round robin.

The teams in the “A” group will play a single round robin.

The teams in the "A" group will play a single round robin.

Semi-Finals: The top two teams in each group will advance to the semi-finals:

1<sup>st</sup> place "A" group vs Winner Quarter-Final 2

2<sup>nd</sup> place "A" group vs Winner Quarter-Final 1

If Division Championship-Semi-Final winners will play a divisional final game (GM #24) to determine who advances to Super Sunday Weekend.

## Twelve (12) Teams

Teams will be divided into two groups - this will require 18 round robin games.

The first group ("A") will be divided into two sub groups:

Group "A-1" will consist of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> place teams.

Group "A-2" will consist of the 4<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup>, place teams.

The teams in the "A-1" group will play each team in the "A-2" group, once.

At the end of the group “B” round robin, the top four teams, out of six, will advance to the group “B” quarter-finals:

Quarter-Final B1: 1 vs 4

Quarter-Final B2: 2 vs 3

The quarter final winners will advance to the Semi-Finals.

## SEMI-FINAL & CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES

A two (2) hour lapse must be scheduled between the end of the semi-final games and the beginning of the championship games.

## SUPER SUNDAY

Goals for average based on the end of regular season standings will be used to seed teams on Super Sunday. Teams travelling the farthest will play the second game where possible.

Example 1<sup>st</sup> vs 4<sup>th</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> vs 3<sup>rd</sup>  
 2<sup>nd</sup> vs 3<sup>rd</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> vs 4<sup>th</sup>
